MEDICAL INSURANCE FOR BOARDERS

It is a requirement for all international students to provide proof of appropriate medical cover when applying for and renewing a study permit with the Department of Home Affairs.

Further to this, entry to local hospitals has become problematic when pupils are unable to provide proof of medical insurance, and it is not uncommon for them to be turned away without it.

Bishops is therefore requesting that all international students and long-distance boarders submit details of their cover or a membership card to the College Sanatorium before entering the school.
