INFORMATION FOR APPLICANTS

APPLICATION PROCEDURE

- All prospective music students must fill in an application form – even if they have already chosen the Music 1 option of Arts & Culture (also known as “Subject Music”).
- Late applications will be put on a waiting list and only considered if there is a place available.
- ALL applications must be returned to the Music Department by **Monday 14th October 2019**.

ARTS & CULTURE – MUSIC 1

- All boys who choose the Music 1 option of Arts & Culture must have achieved a full Grade 2 level on their instrument of choice, as well as completed Grade 2 level theory.
- Boys taking this course are required to have one-hour lessons each week on their instrument, but at 50% of the normal cost for Music lessons (voice pupils only have half an hour per week).
- All boys doing Music 1 **MUST** have lessons on their subject instruments with Bishops teachers.
- All boys who are accepted into the music programme will be on an initial six month probation period.

EXTRA-CURRICULAR

- Please note that **NO** beginner pianists will be accepted. All other instruments are offered, excluding recorder and electronic keyboard.
- All boys who are accepted into the music programme at Bishops will be on an initial six month probation period.

THE INTERVIEW

- The purpose of the interview is for us to get to know a bit about you and what you would like to achieve musically while you are at the College.
- You should be prepared for the following at your interview:
 - You will be asked to play two pieces of contrasting styles which you have prepared.
 - You may be asked to play scales and arpeggios appropriate to the practical level that you have achieved.
 - You may be asked to play a short piece of sight-reading appropriate to the practical level that you have achieved.
 - You may be asked to answer questions of a general nature.
- The interview should not take longer than 10 minutes.

INTERVIEW DATES

- Boys who are coming from **Bishops Prep** will be interviewed during school time on **Monday 28th of October** at the Prep School, with the exception of clarinetists and saxophonists, who will be interviewed on the afternoon of **Tuesday 29th of October** at the College.
- All String players will be interviewed on the **Monday 28th of October** between 13:30 – 14:30 at the College.
- Interviews for all boys coming from **all other schools** will take place on the afternoons of the **28th & 29th of October**. Bookings for these interviews are to be made by calling Iona Beukes (Music Dept Administrator) on 021 659 1036, between 10:30 and 17:00.

THEORY ASSESSMENT

All boys who choose the “Arts and Culture: Music 1” option and have not passed an official Grade 2 Theory Examination will be required to write a Theory Assessment. This assessment will be written immediately after their interview and will take approximately 45 minutes to complete.
