

Dear Grade 10 Parents

An important part of the Epic is the outreach programme. As has previously been communicated, the boys will be participating in outreach programmes at two local junior schools in the Cederberg: Elizabethfontein and Grootkloof. This year remains slightly different to years in the past due to Covid, but we would still like to go ahead and plan these programmes and activities. All necessary precautions will be taken, and strict Covid protocols will be followed. These outreach initiatives are being organised by a group of Grade 10 parents, who could use your assistance if you are in a position to do so.

There are 298 children across the two schools of which 158 are girls and 140 are boys.

The committee needs to achieve 3 things:

1. Raise money to purchase activities & craft materials for our boys to do with the school kids

2. Collect second-hand/gently used items from the Bishops community that have been specifically requested by the schools, as well as new stationery, toiletries, socks etc.

3. Knit blankets for the children in the hostels - if you are unable to knit, please consider donating a fleece blanket as that would be much appreciated.

1. Raising the Money

2. Collection of second-hand and new goods for the schools' "wish lists"

We also have a "wish list" from each school, and although some of the items may be out of our reach this year, we have included them in case you have a contact that could provide certain items or if you, as a parent, are able to assist.

Why don't you try and fill your son's Hi-Tec boot box with as many of the smaller items as possible!

Schools supplies:

- Suitable children's books in good condition (English and Afrikaans for Gr R 7). The children at these two schools speak Afrikaans first language so the donation of Afrikaans books is extremely useful
- Complete children's jigsaw puzzles, games and cards like Old Maid, Uno, Go Fish etc, dominoes and draughts, snakes and ladders etc (if we are able to collect even one game per child it would make a huge difference)
- Lego pieces and planks
- Unused stationery (exam pads, pens, pencils, colouring sets, wax crayons, rulers, erasers, sharpeners, Pritt, scissors etc.)
- Old sporting equipment (soccer balls, net balls, cricket bats and balls, rugby balls, volleyballs and tennis balls, skipping ropes)
- Ball pumps
- A4 copy paper (e.g. Xerox)
- USB's
- Gr 7 calculators x 40 Sharp model EL231 or similar
- Mathematical/Geometry sets x 40 (complete sets only please)
- Short white socks for girls (sizes 12-3 and 4-7)
- Long grey socks for boys (sizes 12-3 and 4-7)

- Educational posters for classroom walls such as world maps, alphabet and number chart

Toiletry/care packs :

Each child will be given a toiletry pack (298 children)

If you would like to donate, can you please donate all 5 items so we do not find ourselves in a position where we have 100 toothbrushes and only 20 toothpastes.

- 2. 100g bar of bath soap
- 3. Toothbrush
- 4. Toothpaste
- 5. Deodorant boy or girl

We would also like to collect packs of sanitary pads for the girls

Bigger donations from the "wish lists" of both schools:

- Garden tools
- 15mm pipes for the sprinkler system of which 100m is required
- 15mm elbow and T connectors for sprinkler system
- Compost for the gardens
- Shade cloth for the garden
- Paving (600mm cement blocks)
- Data projector/s
- Smart Tv's for classrooms
- Radio/CD players
- Upgrading of toilets painting and blinds for windows
- Bedding for boarding house mattresses, duvets, cushions, linen (single beds)
