

CRITERIA FOR HALF COLOURS/FULL COLOURS AND DISTINCTION AWARDS IN FENCING

FULL COLOURS:

- Full colours are awarded at the discretion of the Teacher in Charge of Fencing.
- To be eligible for full colours, a fencer must
 - Be placed in the top 5 at a national competition twice in one season, and
 - o Be in the top 3 ranked in FWC for a particular weapon and age group.
 - Have a 75% attendance rate at club practice.
 - o Be a senior in grade 10-12

HALF COLOURS:

- Half colours are awarded at the discretion of the Teacher in Charge of Fencing.
- To be eligible for half colours, a fencer must
 - o Be placed in the top 10 at a national competition in one season, and
 - Be in the top 10 ranked in FWC for a particular weapon and age group over two seasons.
 - Have a 75% attendance rate at club practice.
 - o Be a senior in grade 10-12

DISTINCTION:

- The highest award to be given to a fencer who has:
 - Achieved junior or senior South African colours and team selection while still a school student and
 - Participated as a South African national team member at an international or All African event.
 - Have a 75% attendance rate at club practice.
